J. PC15-202MU, Master Plan, Bowersox

Ms. Reppert entered the entire staff report into the record. The Applicant is requesting a modification to Section 417, Table 417-1, Uses, Densities/Intensities and Land Allocation, to reduce the non-

residential land use area to 0% and increase the residential to 79%. There was no public comment on this item.

Planning Commission Action:

This is the first of two required public hearings, so no vote was taken.

K. PC15-171ZMA, Zoning Map Amendment, 419 W. South Street (Former Frederick County Jail/Rescue Mission)

Ms. Martinkosky entered the entire staff report into the record. There was public comment on this item.

Arnold Farlow, Frederick Rescue Mission spoke briefly about the history of the Frederick Rescue Mission. He stated that there are not any historical assets that need to be preserved or cared for. He feels the use of the property should take precedence over what historic preservation values there are. Mr. Farlow said that placing the Historic Overlay on the property would burden the mission and opposes of the request.

Michael Proffitt & Associates, stated that he feels that this is a misapplication. He added that they have reviewed the backup documents attached to the staff report and feel that they are little shallow. He opposes the request.

Commissioner McConnell moved for a positive recommendation to the Mayor & Board of Aldermen to apply a Historic Preservation Overlay (HPO) zone to the Former Frederick County Jail (now Frederick Rescue Mission) at 419 W. South Street. This former jail complex possesses the significance and historic integrity to meet the Criteria A, D(1), and D(2) for designation and the proposed HPO is consistent with the City's Comprehensive Plan, Historic Resource Element 5 & 6 and the Frederick National Historic District is identified as an area eligible for HPO designation. The Planning Commission supports the expansion existing Frederick Town Historic Preservation Overlay District by adding this property to the district if the opportunity should arise.
