Upon arrival victim was uncooperative. However, advised a Suspect entered through front door and began assaulting victim. Suspect then left residence. (Suspended)</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>21-007433– 4th Degree Burglary – 160 Willowdale Dr</u> Victim believes estranged wife broke into home and hacked computer. No signs of force, report states that victim suffers from mental illness/paranoia. (Suspended)</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Theft of auto (2) 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>21-014644 – Vehicle Theft – 1400 Baker PL W</u> Victim stated that around 0200hrs he heard his vehicle (2018 Dodge Charger) start in the parking lot. Looked out the window and observed his vehicle being driven from the parking lot. Victim in possession of both keys. Vehicle was located in Atlanta, GA approximately 1 month after report. (Closed)</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>21-020238– Vehicle Theft –104 Waterland Way</u> Victim reported that he arrived home accompanied by two unknown females. When he awoke the next morning around 0800hrs, both females and his rental vehicle were no longer at his residence. Victim located his own vehicle in Hagerstown, MD. (Closed)</p>

Upon arrival, officer observed radio to be missing and ignition ‘punched out’. Contact made with owner, no witness(s) or Suspect(s). Total value-\$300.00. (Suspended)</p>

	<p><u>21-021573 – Theft from Vehicle – 1465 Key pkwy</u> Victim reported a theft from motor vehicle with a 3 week timeframe. Parked his work van, secured. When victim returned to vehicle discovered that the back door lock had been broken and numerous tool had been stolen out of the van valuing approximately \$1200.00. (Suspended Investigation)</p> <p><u>21-017924 – Theft from Vehicle –810 Blakey CT</u> Victim reported that she discovered her vehicle rummaged though. Spare change missing from coin holder valuing \$3.00. Unsecured vehicle. (Suspended Investigation)</p> <p><u>21-015723-Theft from Vehicle- 154 Willowdale Dr</u> Victim stated that someone broke lock on work van and stole tools. Unknown value-no witness(s) or suspect(s). (Suspended Investigation)</p> <p><u>21-016294-Theft from Vehicle-1479 Key Pkwy</u> Victim advised that his work van was broken into. Further, victim advised that the back lock to the van was ‘punched out.’ Numerous tools were taken totaling approximately \$260.00 while the lock replacement was estimated at \$200.00. Victim stated that the vehicle has not been moved in some time, and he was unsure when incident occurred. No witness(s) or suspect(s). (Suspended Investigation)</p> <p><u>21-016036-Theft from Vehicle-150 Willowdale Dr</u> Victim advised his work van was broken in to and power tools were taken. Victim observed side door lock to be broken and door was ajar. Various tools taken having an approximate value of \$2175.00. . No witness(s) or suspect(s). (Suspended Investigation)</p> <p><u>21-014003-Theft from Vehicle-160 Willowdale Dr</u> Victim advised her unsecured vehicle, was entered and rummaged through. Apple iPad, two wallets, and miscellaneous cards and ID taken from vehicle. Suspects attempted to use stolen cards at local stores. Officer was able to investigate those fraudulent charges and ultimately identified the suspect utilizing CCTV footage. Criminal charges were filled through the district court commissioner. (Arrest pending-summons issued)</p>
